MANOR PRIMARY SPORTS PREMIUM 2017-18

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by central government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. At present the funding is being given for two years. Each year the school will receive a lump sum per eligible pupil which is £19890 for Manor Primary School for 2017-2018

At our school the money is being used in the following ways

- 1) To give staff an opportunity to work alongside PE specialists to improve quality of PE lessons raise fitness levels
- 2) To develop a lunchtime physical activity offer for all age groups in order to increase participations in physical activities across lunch times
- 3) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils.

The cost will be as follows

Sports coaches to work alongside staff in order to improve quality of PE provisions and deliver 3 staff meetings across school year	£750	Improved staff subject knowledge in delivering Physical Education that will challenge, engage and motivate pupils and improve fitness
Dance sessions across the school year (term for KS 1, Term for lower KS 2 and term for Upper KS2) led by dance specialist teacher providing additional sports lessons across the school year exceeding minimum 2 hours per week	£8000	Increased participation of all KS 1 and 2 pupils in PE learning opportunities. So they exceed the minimum of 2 hours PE a week by 45 mins each pupil
Contribution towards swimming costs so that all year 4 pupils can swim across the school year	£5630	Increased participation of all 2 pupils in PE learning opportunities. So they exceed the minimum of 2 hours PE a week by another 45 mins each pupil
