PARENTS/ CARERS EVENING SUMMER TERM

A reminder that our summer term parents/ carers evening will be done in the same way as it was last summer. This term families will have an end of year report outlining children's progress made in learning over the year, their levels of attainment and the targets they need to work on in order to further improve. Parents and carers can then come into school Thursday 13th July between 3.45p.m. and 6.30 p.m. to look at children's work and informally talk to your child's teacher and teaching assistant. If you want an appointment to specifically ask questions about your child's report this will also be accommodated and an appointment slip will be sent out with children's reports when more details of this parents/ carers evening is sent to families. Children again will not be allowed to go to classrooms or to appointments with staff. If this is impossible for you your child will be asked to wait in a room where they can be supervised by staff whilst you have your appointment and look at your child's work. The Autumn and Spring term parents and carers evenings will then take the usual format.
