CHILDREN'S UNIVERSITY GRADUATION

As previously communicated this year children who have 100 hours from their extracurricular learning (since they last graduated or from the start) will graduate from the children's university with a gold award. If your child has achieved a gold award and is being invited to Graduate a letter will be sent to you today.

You will then receive a programme for the graduation. This programme is your ticket and admits two people. The Graduation takes place at University of Wolverhampton, Wulfruna Street, Wolverhampton, WV1 1LY on Wednesday 28th June at 4.30p.m..

Your programme will seat two people only. Obviously there are restrictions on numbers in the audience as there are only a certain number of seats.

There is no late admittance as the University will not let anyone in once the graduation begins. Children who have achieved 30 hours (bronze) and 60 hours (silver) this year will be presented with a certificate in assembly before the end of term. Their hours will then be carried forward to next year.

PARENTS/ CARERS EVENING SUMMER TERM
