Progress and Standards Achieved

Reading

- By the end of the summer term, (5 PP children) progress of PP was 4.4 and XPP was 4.7 indicating progress significantly above expected rates.

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, (5 PP children) progress of PP was 4.6 which was higher than XPP (4.4) indicating progress above expected rates.

Number

- By the end of the summer term, (5 PP children) progress of PP was 3.6 and XPP was 4.1 indicating progress slightly above expected rates of 3 points.

Shape, space and measure

- By the end of the summer term, (5 PP children) progress of PP was 3.6 and XPP was 4.0 indicating expected progress.

Strengths

- In reading and writing, progress for PP children was significantly above 3 points. In number, space, shape and measures, progress of PP children was still above the expected progress of 3 points.

Reading

- By the end of the summer term, (9 PP children) progress of PP was 6.7 and XPP was 6.7 indicating progress slightly above expected rates.

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, (9 PP children) progress of PP was 6.6 which was higher than XPP (6.4) indicating progress slightly above expected rates.

Number

- By the end of the summer term, (9 PP children) progress of PP was 5.9 and XPP was 5.9 indicating progress slightly below expected rates of 6 points.

Shape, space and measure

- By the end of the summer term, (9 PP children) progress of PP was 6.0 and XPP was 5.9 indicating expected progress.

Strengths

Progress and Standards Achieved

Reading

- By the end of the summer term, 8 PP children (9 children) within year 1 made expected progress in Reading and all 8 children achieved age related expectations for reading attaining 12 points/ASI.

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, 7 PP children (9 children) within year 1 made expected progress in writing and all 7 children achieved age related expectations for reading attaining 12 points/ASI.
- Over all attainment of PP children was 12.3 which was higher than XPP 12.0

Mathematics

- By the end of the Summer term, 8 PP children (9 children) within year 1 made expected progress in Maths and all children achieved age related expectations for reading attaining 12 points/ASI
- Over all attainment of PP children was 12.6 which was higher than XPP 12.2 and in year progress 4.0 expected progress but again higher than XPP – 3.7 points progress.

Strengths

- Across maths, reading and writing PP children have made progress to narrow the gap between XPP children. PP children have by the end of the year, made the expectation of 4+ points and more progress from Y1 Baseline in reading and maths.
- In year progress of PP children was higher than that of XPP children in Maths, reading and Writing.

Progress and Standards Achieved

Reading

- By the end of the Summer term, all PP children (13 children) within year 2 made expected progress (100%) in Reading and 4-6% made more than expected progress. 12 children attained 16 points or more achieving age related expectations of A2S. 1

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, all PP children (13 children) within year 2 made slightly better than expected progress in writing. 11 children attained 16 points of more achieving age related expectation of A2S.
- PP children overall made 4.5 progress across the year compared to 4.2 by XPP (48 children)

Mathematics

- By the end of the Summer term, 12 PP children within year 2 made expected progress (92%) in Mathematics.

Strengths

Across maths, reading and writing PP children have made progress to narrow the gap between XPP children. PP children have by the end of the year, made the expectation of 4 points and more progress from Y1 Summer.

- 12 PP children are working at age related expectations for year 2 within reading, 11 children within writing and 12 children for maths (A2S)

Progress and Standards Achieved

Reading

- By the end of the Summer term, all PP children (9 children) within year 3 made slightly better than expected progress (100%) in Reading. 5 children attained 20 points achieving age related expectations of A3S.

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, 2 PP children within year 3 made expected progress in writing and 7 PP children made below expected progress.

Mathematics

- By the end of the summer term, 6 PP children within year 3 made slightly better expected progress (67%) in Mathematics.

Strengths

Across maths, reading and writing PP children have made progress to narrow the gap between XPP children. PP children have by the end of the year, made the expectation of 4 points progress and slightly more from Y1 Summer.

Progress and Standards Achieved

Reading

- By the end of the summer term, all PP children (11 children) within year 4 made slightly better than expected progress in Reading achieving progress of 8.6 overall.

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, PP children did not reach age related expectations of an A+S (24) as attainment was 21.9 Progress from KSI was 8.0 which was expected progress

Mathematics

- Progress overall from KSI was 8.1 which was just slightly above expected progress and this was higher than XPP with a progress of 7.8.

Strengths

Across maths, reading and writing PP children have made progress to narrow the gap between XPP children. PP children have by the end of the year, made the expectation of 8 points progress from KSI.

Progress and Standards Achieved

Reading

- By the end of the summer term, all PP children (22 children) within year 6 made better than expected progress in Reading achieving in year progress of 4.6 and 16.8 overall from KSI.

Writing

- By the end of the summer term, all PP children (22 children) within year 6 made better than expected progress in within writing achieving in year progress of 5.0 and 16.8 overall from KSI.

Mathematics

- By the end of the summer term, all PP children (22 children) within year 6 made better than expected progress in writing achieving in year progress of 4.7 and 16.6 overall from KSI.

Strengths
