Sports Premium 2016-17

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by central government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. At present the funding is being given for two years. Each year the school will receive a lump sum per eligible pupil which is £9790 for Manor Primary School for 2016-2017

At our school the money is being used in the following ways

- 1) To give staff an opportunity to work alongside PE specialists to improve quality of PE lessons raise fitness levels
- 2) To develop a lunchtime physical activity offer for all age groups in order to increase participations in physical activities across lunch times
- 3) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils.

The cost will be as follows:

So they minimum of 2 hours PE a week by 45 mins each pupil
