Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our History curriculum next term we intend to take Year 4 children on a visit to Warwick Castle. During this visit the children will have the opportunity to explore the castle and its grounds and experience life from long ago.

The visit will take place on Friday 9th March. We will leave school at 9.00am and return for the end of the school day. The cost of this visit will be £14.50 per child to include entrance to the castle and transportation.

Unfortunately, Warwick Castle only operates a non-refundable payment system therefore we have to ask for an initial payment of £6.50 to cover the cost of the entrance into the Castle. If your child was absent for any reason on this day, they do offer a ticket to visit at a later date.

If you would like your child to take part, please complete the consent slip below and return it to school with a non-refundable deposit of £6.50 by Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January. The remainder of the money will be due by Tuesday 27th February. Alternatively you will be sent a text message with a link to a website where you can securely log in and make payment with a credit or debit card.
