I will enjoy reading and retelling a range of traditional tales.
I will be retelling stories in my own words.
I will create re-enactments of stories in forms of role play.
I will look at the beginning and ends of traditional tales and investigate whether they always have a happy ending
I will look at and join in with repetitive phrasing in stories.

Maths

I will explore sizes in traditional tales.
I will use language big, medium sized little to compare by size.
I will compare and order size of objects using vocabulary related to size, length, and height.
I will measure ingredients-making porridge, baking gingerbread men, making fairy cakes using vocabulary of capacity.
I will enjoy looking for and using numbers in fairy stories
I will make sets of objects that belong to each story and label them with the matching numeral?

I will enjoy making large buildings from Traditional Tales using a range of construction materials, developing my gross motor movements.
I will use smaller construction equipment to make castles/bridges chairs /houses.
I will enjoy travelling in different ways –animals/Billy goats etc
I will negotiate objects and adapt my speed as I use fast / slow movements.

I will listen to others one to one or in small groups.
I will listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
I will join in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.
