

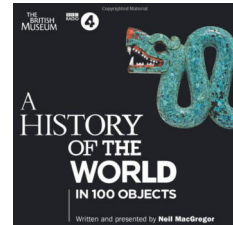


## Year 4 Top 10 Home Learning Ideas

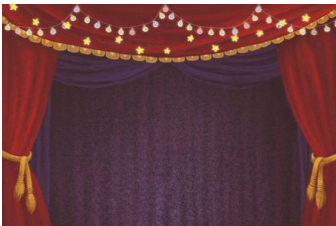
**Idea 1—Around the world in 20 historical items.** Imagine you are setting up a museum of world artefacts. Can you think of 20 historical items from 20 different countries that you would showcase in your museum?



**Idea 2—The Very Special Party**—You are allowed to have a very special party. You are only allowed to invite 6 people to this party. These people can be from the present or the past. They can be anyone who you would really love to meet. Explain why you would invite each person and write three questions you would ask each of them—what do you really want to know. Think carefully, you can only ask these questions so don't waste them.



**Idea 3—Being helpful at home**—Learn how to make



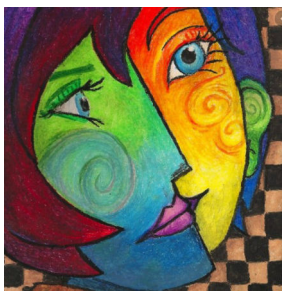
your bed. Change the duvet, the pillow cases and the bottom sheet. Now make your bed look neat every morning when you get up.

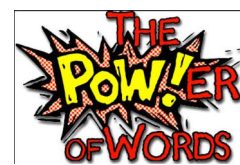
