I will look forward to making lots of new friends.




Each morning I will walk onto the playground and wait for my classroom door to open.








This is the cloakroom. I will find my peg and hang my belongings on my peg.




Then I sensibly walk down the corridor to my classroom.

In Year I, I will learn lots of new and exciting things. This includes:



In English, we will continue developing our phonetic knowledge using Floppy's Phonics Sounds and Letters. We will read and retell key stories, fairy tales and traditional tales and predict what might happen next. We will also understand and explain the difference between fiction and non-fiction texts. When writing, we will sequence ideas chronologically and use punctuation including capital letters and full stops.



In Mathematics, we will develop our knowledge of number and place value, strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as investigating fractions, measures (including length, height, weight and volume), properties of shape, statistics and position and direction.



We will work scientifically when carrying out investigations. We will find out more about animals, including humans, everyday materials, plants and seasonal changes.



In Computing, we will investigate the use of internet, understand what algorithms are and explore digital texts, as well as attempting to create our own!



In Geography, we will develop our knowledge of our local community and will investigate the UK and seaside locations.



As we delve into the past, in History, we will compare schools now and then, learn about Our Kings and Queens as well as the impact Famous Caring people have had.



In RE, we will learn from religion and about religion. We will reflect on our own beliefs, compare them to the beliefs of others. We will also be introduced to two major religions—Christianity and Sibhism



In PHSCE, we investigate the importance of our health and wellbeing as well as celebrating and respecting our differences.



During Art and Design, we will use a range of art mediums to investigate and create our own collages, sculptures and portraits!



In Design and Technology, we will investigate textiles, structures and cookery. We will design and make our own Christmas Stocking, a house for a familiar character for a story and a tropical fruit snack!



We will hit the high notes in Music as we investigate a range of different musical genres. This includes old school hip hop, reggae, film. pop. classical and folk.



In PE, we will work on key skills such as agility, balance, and co-ordination during a range of activities. This includes gymnastics, dance, net and wall games and invasion games.
