### In Year 3, I will learn lots of new and exciting things. This includes:



In English, we will read with increasing fluency, retell stories and predict what might happen next. We will also discuss our thoughts about a range of text types and use evidence from the text to make simple inferences. When writing, we will sequence ideas, use expanded noun phrases for description, use a wider range of conjunctions to link ideas in sentences and punctuation including commas, inverted commas and apostrophes.



In Mathematics, we will develop our knowledge of number and place value, strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as investigating fractions, measures (including length, height, weight and volume), properties of shape, statistics and position and direction.



We will work scientifically when carrying out investigations. We will find out more about animals, including humans, forces and magnets, lights and shadows, rocks and soils and what helps plants grow.



In Geography, we will explore our country before drawing comparisons to two field stories – a community in France and Brazil!



In RE, we will investigate how the world began according to religions around the world, how Jewish people express their beliefs and what religions are represented in the city.



During Art and Design, we will use a range of art mediums to investigate portraits and painting, modern art and pop art and pattern and print!



We will hit the high notes in Music as we investigate a range of different musical genres. This includes R&B, classical, soul and mowtown, disco and reggae.



In Computing, we will investigate the use of the internet, how to keep a blog, how animation works as well as collecting and recording data!



As we delve into the past, in History, we will investigate what life was life for children in WWII, who the Romans were and life during the Stone Age to Iron Age.



In PHSCE, we will investigate the importance of our health and wellbeing, celebrate and respect our differences and the importance of having a voice and rights.



In Design and Technology, we will investigate textiles, structures, and cookery. We will design and make our own biscuits, an electrical torch and a treasure box for our precious rocks!



In PE, we will work on key skills during a range of activities. This includes gymnastics, dance, net and wall games, striking and fielding invasion games.



We will develop our French listening, speaking, reading and writing skills when exploring Moi (All about Me), On fait la fete (Celebrations) and Ma Famille et Mes Amis (My Family and Friends)
