I will walk up the stairs and along the corridor to the cloakroom.






I will find my peg and hang my belongings on my peg.

In Year 6, I will learn lots of new and exciting things. This includes:



In English, we will read with increasing fluency, retell stories and predict what might happen next. We will also discuss our thoughts about a range of text types and use evidence from the text to make inferences about characters feelings and emotions. When writing, we will sequence ideas, use a range of sentence types, use vocabulary to engage the reader and punctuation including colons, semi-colons and hyphens to clarify meaning.



In Mathematics, we will develop our knowledge of number and place value, strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as investigating fractions, measures (including length, height, weight and volume), properties of shape, statistics and position and direction.



We will work scientifically when carrying out investigations. We will find out more about Electricity, Investigate Light and how we see things, Evolution and Inheritance, Animals including Humans and Living things and their Habitats. In Geography, we will explore Rivers and Coasts, Physical and

Human Features of the Caribbean

as well as a study of our Capital

City - London.

We will hit the high notes in Music as we investigate a range of different musical genres. This includes Pop, Motown, Jazz, Gospel and Bhangra.


