The Bible contains 66 books, written by around 40 authors. The authors of the Bible were inspired by God to write their ideas down. It is split into two parts: the Old Testament and the New Testament.

## Creation Story

## What does the word Christian mean?

The words 'Christian' and 'Christianity' come from the name, 'Jesus Christ.'



**Old Testament** - the first part of the Christian Bible containing the books from the Jewish faith. There are 39 books in the Old Testament which explore stories before Jesus was born.

**New Testament** - the second part of the Christian Bible. It has 27 books and tell us about the life of Jesus, going beyond his resurrection.

**Gospels** - Four books in the New Testament that tell us about Jesus' life, from his birth up to his death and resurrection.
