What does the Bible contain?	The Bible is a sacred book for Christians. It is treated with respect by those who use it. Christians believe that the words in the Bible are important and were revealed by God. This is known as revelation. The Bible has been translated into more than 600 languages. The Bible contains 66 books, written by around 40 authors. The authors of the Bible were inspired by God to write their ideas	<b>Bible?</b> Christians read the Bible because it contains rules and advice from God. They may talk to other Christians about what it means to them. Some Christians study the Bible.
