Design - A plan or drawing produced to show the look and function or workings of a building, garment, or other object before it is made. **Design criteria** - The explicit goals that a project must achieve in order to be successful. Christmas stocking - A long sock or similar receptacle hung up by children on Christmas Eve for Father Christmas to fill with presents. **Purpose** - The reason for which something is done or created or for which something exists. **User** - A person who uses or operates a product. Fabrics - Cloth or other material produced by weaving or knitting fibres. **Pattern** – The template from which the parts of a garment are traced onto woven or knitted fabrics before being cut out and assembled. **Joining** – To connect two pieces of fabric together. **Stitch** – make, mend, or join (something) with stitches. **Decoration** - The process or art of decorating something. Suitable - Right or appropriate for a particular person, purpose, or situation. **Template** - A gauge, pattern, or mold (such as a thin plate or board) used as a guide to the form of a piece being made. **Prototype** - A prototype is an early sample, model, or release of a product built to test a concept or process. **Thread** - A long, thin strand of cotton, nylon, or other fibres used in sewing or weaving. Sew - Join, fasten, or repair (something) by making stitches with a needle and thread or a
