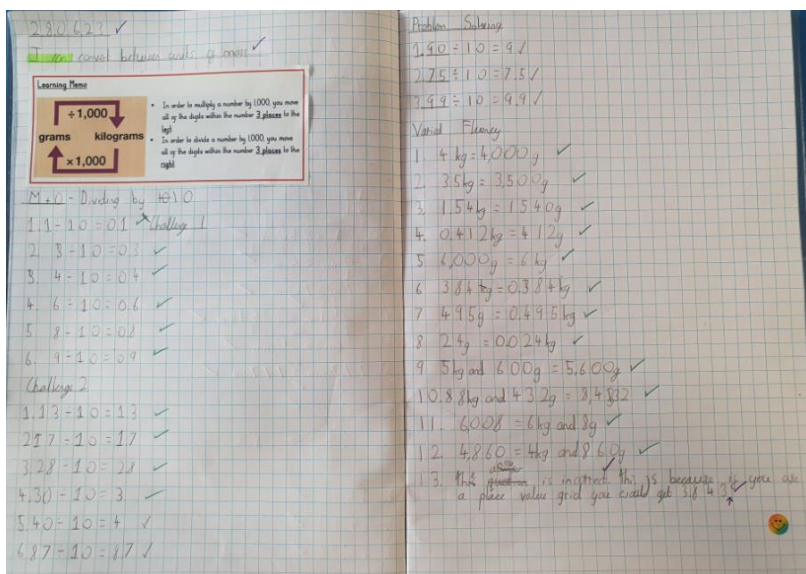
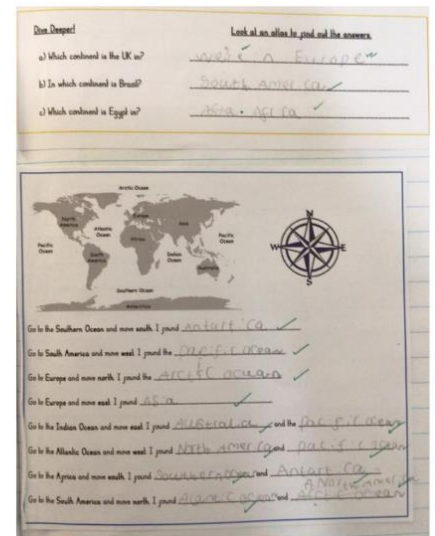
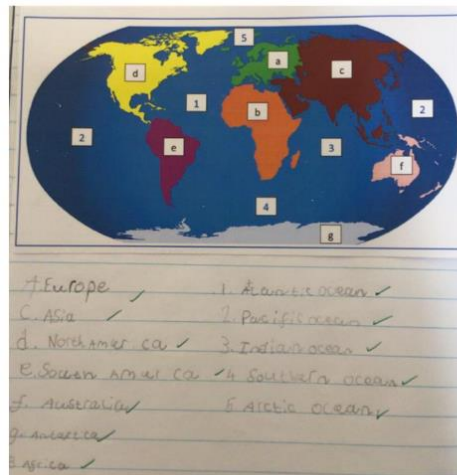


## Nursery
